New Cell Phone Law

Georgia law prohibits texting while driving. Gov. Perdue signed two bills effective July 1 that ban texting while driving and the use of any wireless device by school bus drivers and drivers under 18 years of age. Violating these laws can result in the addition of one point to your license, suspension of your license, and/or a minimum fine of \$150. For more information visit, www.gahighwaysafety.org.

Elections reminder

Early/absentee voting for the 2010 Primary Election is open now through July 16 at the Elections Office at 455 Grayson Highway in Lawrenceville from 9:00 am to 4:30pm M-F. Another option is to request an absentee ballot by calling 678.226.7210 or download the form from the Secretary of State's website. The application can either be mailed to the elections office or faxed to 678.226.7209. Advance voting will open in four additional locations the week prior to the July 20 Election Day from 9:00am to 7:00pm July 12-16 at Community Centers at Lucky Shoals Park in Norcross, George Pierce Park in Suwanee, Centerville in Snellville, and the Dacula Activity Building in Dacula.
